Trustee Metcalf moved to award the bid for the additional driveways for the expansion at the Sherman City Cemetery to Wilcox Excavating for \$3890.00, supported by Treasurer Chaffee, motion carried.

Treasurer Chaffee moved to allow the clerk to order markers for the Sherman City Cemetery expansion, supported by Trustee Dutcher, motion carried.

The library would like the signs they have put up around town to direct people to the library – Supervisor Sides is to contact the road commission about getting these put up.

Trustee Dutcher moved to hire Stanley Shaner this year at the same rate as last year for snow plowing of township properties, supported by Trustee Metcalf, motion carried.

Treasurer Chaffee moved to send the Clerk to an MTA “Advanced Township Government Skills” training, supported by Trustee Metcalf, motion carried.

Discussion on zoning issues was held. Supervisor Sides is to contact the township attorney to set up his attendance at a regular meeting to review the zoning issues.

Trustee Dutcher moved to adjourn, supported by Treasurer Chaffee, motion carried, meeting adjourned at 8:50 pm.
