Trustee Oplinger moved to approve the agenda, Treasurer Chaffee supported, motion carried.

Treasurer Chaffee moved to approve the minutes of 8/17/2015, Trustee Lawrence supported, motion carried.

Trustee Oplinger moved to approve Payment of the Bills with voiding ck 14313 to Richard Schmidt and add ck 14326 to Richard Schmidt to correct his check, Treasurer Chaffee supported, motion carried.

Public Comments: Ron Groh and Kevin Moffett both of 7000 block of Airline voiced concerns over the potential of a land split creating parcels for mobile rental units next to their properties.

Planning Commission updated the board on zoning amendment of section 13.06 to change signs at filling stations – no action taken until we receive response from the County Planning Commission, which has not been received as of this meeting.

Trustee Lawrence moved to accept the bid for \$175.00 from Cutting Edge to remove tree and clean up in Sherman City Cemetery – if Trustee Oplinger and Supervisor Thompson look at it and decide they can't do it, Trustee Oplinger supported, motion carried.

Discussion on the Township Land Division Ordinance was held.

Trustee Oplinger moved to approve the contract with the Isabella County Commission on Aging (Oct 1, 2-15- Sept 30, 2016) as presented, Treasurer Chaffee supported, motion carried.

Trustee Lawrence advised the board the Nottawa Sherman Fire Dept Open House is Oct 10 from 10am-2pm, and the firefighters will be waiting tables at Newcombes Restaurant as a fundraiser on Oct 17<sup>th</sup> (NOTE: since the meeting this date has changed to Oct 24<sup>th</sup>).
