Meeting Minutes
August 19, 2024

Meeting held at the Sherman Township Hall, 3550 N Rolland Rd, Weidman, MI 48893

New Business:

Clerk Livermore reported on the preparation of the L4029. Clerk Livermore moved we approve levying the maximum allowed for Twp Operating, Fire Millage and Library millage, Supervisor Johnson supported, motion carried.

Walking trail behind library – was installed by a Friends of the Library group years ago and they were to maintain it – this group is no longer in operation and the trail is grown over and would need a lot of upkeep. It was decided to remove the trail sign and have the benches moved up near the building for people to sit up there and no longer have a trail option.

Allocation of ARPA funds was discussed

CD Renewals were discussed. 2 are up for renewal in Sept. Other up in Oct.

Clerk Livermore moved we add \$100,000 to the Gen Fund CD from the Gen fund checking, Trustee Grey supported, motion carried

Clerk Livermore moved we add \$80,000.00 to the Fire millage CD from the Fire millage checking, Supervisor Johnson supported, motion carried.

Reports and comments from other township entities were heard.

Clerk Livermore will get some prices on plastic tables for next meeting.

Trustee Simon moved to allow the clerk to purchase two additional voting booth stations (using ARPA funds), Trustee Grey supported, motion carried

Supervisor Johnson mentioned replacing our tables at the hall with some lighter ones - Clerk Livermore will get some prices on plastic tables for next meeting. Need to put a good mark where new tree is to go at the park.
